

# Cowboy Church Bass Club Tournament Results

Joe Pool Lake - Loyd Park  
4/26/2006 - 6:00 am 3:30 pm

**Congratulations Brandon Wooddell and George Walker!** They take big bass with 7.31-lb and 1st place team stringer with 9.15-lb. Brandon actually caught 2 bass over the 21 inch slot. Amazingly his first big bass was hooked two times. First on a Carolina rig at around 8:30 am. After the fish was hooked she broke the line. He said he circled back around to the same spot and this time threw a jig and hooded the bass a 2nd time. He said he knew he hooked her twice because he found his broken Carolina rig still in her mouth. Brandon's second fish over 21 inches around 9:00 am on a Carolina rig. Both fish were caught in the upper end of the lake in about 10-ft of water. He said he was not sight fishing and could not see them before they were caught. Brandon said he used 15 pound Berkley Big Game line to catch the first big bass and he used 14 pound fluorocarbon to catch the second big bass.

## LAKE CONDITIONS

The air temperature was 53 at 6:00 am and 73 at 4:00 pm. The water temperature was between 68 and 70. The skies were cloudy and the water was muddy in the creeks. The winds were light to breezy depending on the time of day.

The slot length limit is a 14-21 slot. Bass 14 inches and less or 21 inches or greater in length may be retained. Only one bass 21 inches or greater may be retained each day. Teams can only weigh-in one bass 21 inches or greater.

## THE RESULTS

34 teams fished.

28 limits were caught.

2 teams zeroed.

90 fish were weighed in.

1.26 pounds was the average.

5 bass were over 21 inches were caught: 7.43-lb (DOA), 7.31-lb, 6.83-lb, 5.72-lbs, 5.37-lb
