

# Cowboy Church Bass Club Tournament Results

Lake Grapevine - August 22, 2009 6:00 am - 1:30 pm Katie Wood Ramp

## **Charlie David / Dillon David win big on Grapevine! George Walker / Brandon Wooddell are the 2009 Anglers of the Year!**

**Congratulations to Charlie David and Dillon David.** They brought in an amazing 15.13 pound stringer and caught the big bass of the tournament. The six pound hawg was good for \$110.00 and the 15.15 pound sack netted them another \$330 for a total of \$440.00 in prize money.

Charlie said their first bass was caught in the willows on a buzz bait. The second bass was caught off a ledge on a drop shot, and their 3rd bass (the big one) was caught in the tires on a jig.

**Anglers of the Year - Congratulations to Brandon Wooddell and George Walker.** Overall they caught more fish than all the other teams. They never had a 1st place win this year but they always caught a limit. Coming in 2nd is not so bad. Brandon and George came in second 4 times this year, but they took home \$1,071.00 in total prize money (more than any other team). This is their second AOY title and they also have the club record for highest year-end points.

## **LAKE CONDITIONS**

The lake was about 3 ft low. The winds were 4 - 7 mph out of the NE. The air temp was 69 - 92. The water temp was 85. The skies were clear. There was a small sliver of a moon the night before. The barometric pressure was steady most of the day at 30.01 - 30.05. The water was stained. The lake was semi-crowded with the normal party boats and jet skies. Another bass club launched from the same boat ramp. That other tournament started at 5 am and finished at noon. The other club had 16 boats. It took 14 pounds to win (a limit is 5 fish for them) and their big bass was 7.96 pounds.

## **THE RESULTS**

22 teams fished

16 limits were caught (a limit is 3 fish with a 14-18 inch no keep slot)

4 teams zeroed.

52 fish were weighed in with a weight of 65.63 pounds.

1.35 pounds was the average fish weight.

20% given to the church.....\$220.00

10% given to the club.....\$110.00

10% big bass.....\$110.00  
\$660.00 balance divided.....first 50%, second 30%, third 10%, forth 5%, & fifth 5%
