

# Cowboy Church Bass Club Tournament Results

**Joe Pool Lake - June 27, 2009** 6:00 am - 1:00 pm **Loyd Park**

Hot weather brings hot fishing!

**Congratulations to James Cook.** He almost beat the club record with a 10.98 pound bass and so far, it's the big bass of the year. It was so big that she almost didn't fit in the weigh-in basket. **Dillon Cook** and **James's** took first place team with 12.75 pounds and combined with big bass took home \$580.00. James said he caught 3 bass over 21 inches (lake rules allow only 1 bass over 21 to be kept). His biggest fish was caught within the last hour of the tournament in deep water on a Texas rig worm. ## LAKE CONDITIONS

The lake was full. The winds were 4 - 6 mph out of the SE. The air temp was 80 - 98. The water temp was 86 at the start. The skies were clear. There was a little less than a 1/2 moon the night before. The barometric pressure didn't move much. It started out at 29.83, rose to 29.85 at 11:00 am and fell back down to 29.83 by 1:00 pm. All the grass in the lake was killed by the controlling authorities. It was hot and muggy.

1.24 pounds was the average fish weight.

It took at least a 5 pounder to get a check.....**Kenneth** and **Scott Mohone** had the best stringer without an "OVER".....**Todd Stewart** and **Michael McAnulty** caught their big bass on a hump in 15-ft of water on a DD-22 crank bait around 10:30 am.....**Joe Crouch** caught his big bass on a paddle tail worm Texas rigged around 11:00 am..... **Randy Crabb & Charlie Corvaia** caught their big bass on a Texas rig next to rip-rap around 10:00 am.....**Brian Barfield & Kyle Barfield** caught their big bass around 7:30 am on a Carolina rigged brush hawg in 12-15 ft water.....Several of the over bass were in spawn mode with eggs.....Many anglers reported catching 20 & 1/2 inch bass (in the no keep slot).....**James Cook's** bass was the clubs 2nd biggest (on 10/13/07, **Dennis Vinson** caught a 11.60 on Joe Pool).....**Al & Jon** had a bad morning. Jon couldn't get his outboard motor to start so they were late leaving the launch

site, one of Al's rods broke, and Al lost his glasses on the way to the first hole .....**Teri** and **Reggie** help organize breakfast and a "drive-by lunch". ## LAKE SIDE DEVOTIONAL

Dennis Lambrecht led the devotional. It was hot outside and we were not in the shade, so Dennis kept the devotional short. He was inspired by the club members who were going to be baptized Sunday morning at the lake.

Dennis said Baptism does not add to a person's salvation . A person is saved by trusting Christ. Baptism does not make a person saved. It is also wrong to think that a person is not saved until they are Baptized. The apostle Paul wrote:

**1 Corinthians 1:17** *For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel - not with words of human wisdom, lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power.*

Once a person trusts Christ as their Savior, the next step should be water baptism. Believers in Jesus Christ are commanded to be baptized in water. Simon Peter said to the multitudes on the Day of Pentecost:

**Acts 2:38** *Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.*

Bottom line....Baptism is very important. It's a public profession of faith. If you have trusted Christ as your Savior, then you should be baptized. While this act, in and of itself, will not save you, it will be done as an outward sign of an inward change.
